Job Description**

Position: ASB Equipment Operator
Reports to: Assistant Agricultural Fieldman

Purpose of the Position:

The Equipment Operator position will focus primarily on paratilling of completed road construction borrows and mowing of municipal right of ways.

Typical Duties & Responsibilities:

1. Operation of various agriculture related equipment as directed.
2. Practice equipment preventative maintenance such as oil checking and greasing of implements.
3. Notify Assistant Agricultural Fieldman or Shop Foreman of any necessary repairs.
4. Practice workplace safety.

Working Conditions:

1. The term of this position is approximately April – November and is weather dependent.
2. Summer hours of work are: Monday to Friday 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM.
Spring and fall hours of work are 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM
Change in hours is dependent on the season and weather and will be determined by the Agricultural Fieldman in consultation with the Assistant Agricultural Fieldman.
3. Extra hours may be required from time to time.

Job Specifications:

1. Must be able to operate a variety of agricultural equipment such as tractors, mowers, trucks and trailers, all terrain vehicles, seeding, tillage and spraying equipment.
2. Agricultural Equipment operation experience is an asset but on the job training will be provided.
3. Requires Class 5 license with Q endorsement.
